A child is anyone who is under 18 years of age.



Children also have the right to be safe and protected from harm.

People should never hurt children. Unfortunately, some people do hurt children by hitting them, sexually abusing them, shouting at them or not caring for them.

The Australian Himalayan Foundation works to stop people from hurting children. It is never your fault if someone hurts you. If someone hurts you or you see someone hurting another child during an AHF activity, please speak up and tell an AHF representative. They will listen to you, take you seriously and help you. It is their job to listen to you and help you.
